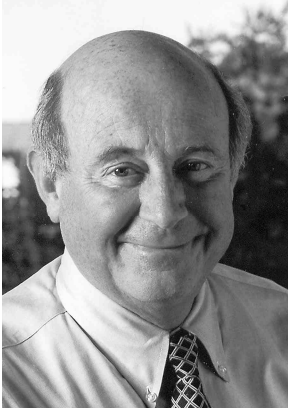

A member of the Koret Task Force on K–12 Education, Paul Hill is a research professor at the University of Washington’s Daniel J. Evans School of Public Affairs and a nonresident senior fellow at the Brookings Institution, where he is leading studies of school choice plans, charter schools, and school accountability. He also directs the Center on Reinventing Public Education, which is funded by foundations and business and develops, tests, and helps communities adopt alternative governance systems for public K–12 education. The holder of a Ph.D. in political science from Ohio State University, his most recent books are *Choice with Equity* (2002) and *Charter Schools and Accountability in Public Education* (2002).
