In addition to his Hoover appointment, Thomas Sargent is a professor of economics at Stanford University. He was previously a member of the Department of Economics at the University of Chicago. The holder of a Ph.D. in economics from Harvard, he is a leader in the field of macroeconomics. His current research focuses on ways to make monetary and fiscal policy during times of uncertainty about the economy; he is also writing a history of the management of the denomination structure of currency. The author of numerous books, his most recent, with Lars Ljungqvist, is *Recursive Macroeconomic Theory* (2000). He is a fellow of the National Academy of Sciences, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and the Econometric Society.
