All citations are placed at the end of the respective paragraph or body of text to which they refer. All references to tables and figures are also placed at the end of the respective paragraph or body of text to which they refer to ensure ease of readability.

All web page addresses were current at the time of manuscript completion; however, due to the changing nature of the World Wide Web, some references may become obsolete over time.

The abbreviation “na” is used throughout *School Figures* to signify that data was “not available.”

Due to the vast amount of numbers used throughout *School Figures*, with rare exception, numbers are rounded to the nearest single decimal or, when deemed appropriate, whole number. In addition, due to rounding, numbers may not add to totals.

Distinction between the usage of “race” and “ethnicity” throughout *School Figures* was determined by usage in the original source material.
