The author of many books, his most recent are *One World Emerging? Convergence and Divergence in Industrial Societies* (1998) and *National Character: A Psycho-Social Perspective* (1997). He is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the American Philosophical Society, and the National Academy of Sciences.
