Appointed as a Hoover fellow in 2002, Ross Johnson serves as an adviser to the Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty (RFE/RL) Archive Project at Hoover. He is also senior adviser to the president of RFE/RL and a member of the Board of Directors of the RFE/RL Fund. The holder of a Ph.D. in political science from Columbia University, he was a senior staff member of the RAND Corporation from 1969 to 1988, where he specialized in East European and Soviet security issues. He was subsequently director of the RFE/RL Research Institute and RFE/RL counselor. His current work focuses on the role of Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty in American national security strategy, the impact of media on international security, and Balkan security issues.
