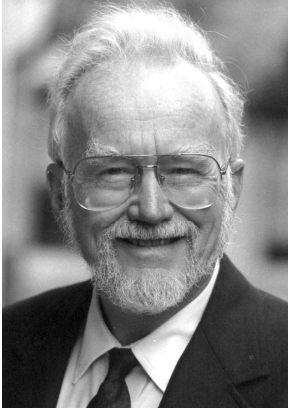


THOMAS GALE MOORE
