In addition to his Hoover appointment, Paul Romer holds an endowed professorship in the Graduate School of Business at Stanford University. The holder of a Ph.D. in economics from the University of Chicago, he has written extensively about economic and social policy issues, including chapters on the politics of entitlement and on the federal government's role in financing health-related research. His current work focuses on the determinants of long-run economic growth. Prior to joining the Hoover Institution in 1995, he was a professor of economics at the University of California, Berkeley. He is a fellow of the Econometric Society and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
